Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act as amended; the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 as amended; and the National Dam Safety Program Act, as amended; and

WHEREAS The Desha County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan, identifies mitigation goals and actions to reduce or eliminate long-term risk to people and property of Desha County from the impacts of future hazards and disasters; and

WHEREAS adoption by Desha County demonstrates its commitment to hazard mitigation and achieving the goals outlined in the Desha County Multijurisdictional Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY DESHA COUNTY, ARKANSAS, THAT:

WHEREAS, upon completion of the feasibility study, the County will request additional funding for future phases as needed.




SECTION I: The County will participate in accordance with its designated responsibilities in this project.

WHEREAS, upon completion of the feasibility study, the County will request additional funding for future phases as needed.


