#### 1. MINUTES

JP 8 Dollie Wilson applauded the positive work that had been completed by Ms. Davis. She stated this would be positive for the growth in Dumas as well as Desha County. JP 2 G. Lynn Weatherford asked who the property belonged to? Ms. Davis stated she purchased the property years ago, but said it was a non-profit ran by a board. She stated it was her property, but it was owned by Widows Empowering Widows.

Desha County Judge, Wayne Smith commented he didn't want to be in the same position as some of the other counties were in and we need to watch the budget closely. He stated he sympathized with Ms. Davis, but needed to take care of the county first. Projected tax revenues are down due to many farms and other businesses closing. JP 3, Patricia Watkins made a motion to not fund the organization until we look at the 2026 budget. It was seconded by JP 8, Dollie Wilson. The roll was called, 9 to 0. All were in favor.
